  - Amy Clecker-half on intervention and half on prevention
  - Shelia Broderick-intervention

- Krystal George- prevention
- Areas: prevention, intervention and awareness
  - Prevention- trainings with undergrad and grad groups
    - bystander intervention, we all have a responsibility to protect strangers and friends when we see unsafe activity
    - gender violence- dating violence, sexual violence, stalking
    - PACT- Prevent act challenge and teach (mostly undergrad)
      - expand to graduate students (field specific)
        - nursing school→ career relevance
    - Chapel Hill- raise the bar- staff and local ownership to do prevention, local outreach
      - qualtrics- what should bar owners and staff know to protect others
- intervention- provide confidential counseling services to graduate, undergraduate and profession students of all genders, races
  - 24/7 hotline
  - no waiting-list
  - can be something that happened outside of Duke
    - try to see people within 24 hours
  - trauma specific counseling
  - case management-title IX rights-responsible accommodations
  - most students do not report
  - advising based on specifics
  - secondary survivors
  - protected confidential relationships- women's center, duke clergy, student health, CAPS
- awareness raising-
  - stickers in on-campus restrooms
  - if you want in your department contact WC, make sure you have permission
  - online training for grad and prof students-
    - Called "Not any more"

- in the future will be mandatory
- help generating ideas on how to promote this training
- by-standard intervention

### **Sexual Misconduct Task Force Hearing Panel**

Jacqueline Robinson-Hamm

- issue of hearing panel
  - if a Duke student is an assailant, the office of student conduct investigates
  - hearing- both assailant and victim present
  - panel- 3 members, 1 student
    - same training
  - undergrads do not want another student overseeing them, fear of running into the other person
  - no graduate students trained
  - undergrad students proposal- have undergrads serve on graduate student panels and vice versa
    - don't want to oversee their peers for issues of bias
      - is this just perception because they are nervous
      - younger students fear of seeing someone later in their academic career
    - big opportunity for training

- Jacqueline- What can I bring back to the task force?
  - Rachel Karasik- how often would they have to sit on an OSC trial?
    - Hard to say because none are trained
    - one-two a year
    - can indicate how much you would be willing to serve
  - Jennifer Rutter (Divinity)- not a lot of overlap with undergrads and grads, knows because resident
  - Allison Saito (Econ PhD)- all misconduct or just sexual misconduct
    - The only time the OSC deals with graduate students is when the assailant is a graduate student
  - Abbe LaBella- what about TAs and Instructors, position of authority ?
  - Lidia Green (ecology)- not much overlap between grad and undergrad, potential solution of local alumni (grad or undergrad)
- Rachel Karasik (NIC)- as graduate students we were all undergrads so we know what it was like
- Connie Cahill- what do the
  - assailant and victim get to see who is on the panel and can ask someone to leave
  - from an ethical standpoint- should re
- Hunter Rudd (MBA)- why not support them? No reason that would preclude any of us.
- Abbe- what about undergraduates sitting on graduate panels? They don't have our experience.
- Allison Saito- less potential for bias, doesn't need to be vice-versa
- Colleen McClean (Medical Scientist Training)- professional and trainee, others who are one-step above graduate students
  - Jacqueline: Larry Moneta-pretty set on keeping students, not employees on panel
- Patricia Bass (art)- graduate student- have someone from a different graduate professional school
- Hunter Rudd (MBA)- not support undergraduate have purview over undergraduate issues
- Jacqueline- informal poll of whether constituents would be interested

- majority yes to serving on undergrad, but no to undergrads serving on ours
- Rep- How to maintain the anonymity of graduate student?
  - panel minutes are sealed, panel is confidential
- Rachel- this is an individual not departmental assignment, this is good professional training
- Jacqueline- students do not see deliberations
  - undergrad perception rather than fact
- Diego Calderon-Arrieta (environ mang)- why did they propose this?
  - Jacqueline-assumption on part of undergrads
- Abhi- what if the victim and assailant are a graduate student and professional student respectively
  - Jacqueline-no real precedent, task force open to ideas
